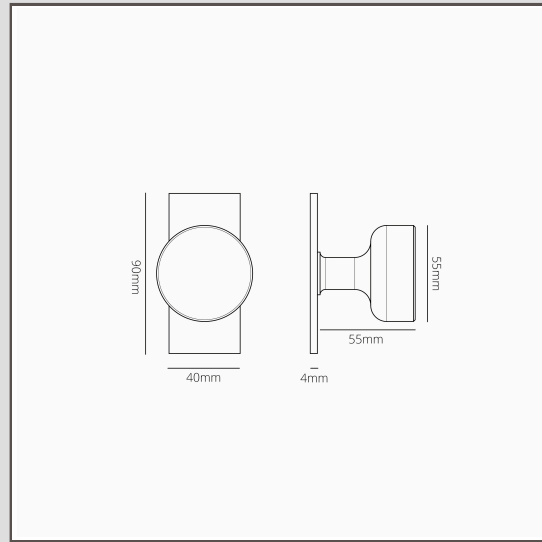


Onslow Short Plate Sprung Door Knob – Polished Nickel

Our flat-fronted Onslow door knob is a contemporary alternative to our beehive design.

This version includes a low-profile, short backplate for a slightly bolder look.

The knob is sprung, which means you don't need to rely on the latch's spring for its movement.

There's also no danger of it coming away in your hand – the spindle is threaded onto the knob which holds it in place.

Polished nickel is our answer to chrome. It's a bit warmer, which we think is more versatile, so you can use it with warm or cool colour palettes.

- Solid brass 4mm backplate with screwless 'front' side
- Super smooth turn thanks to self-lubricating, high-tolerance bushings
- Longer handle neck for a comfortable grip (compared to rose variant)
- Sold in a pair
- Must be installed using our [12mm template profiler router bit](#) and [flat plate routing jig](#)
- Dimensions: handle W54mm x H60mm; plate H90mm x W40mm x D4mm
- Designed for use with a tubular latch or mortice locks
- Suitable for interior doors only
- Minimum door thickness 35mm
- Maximum door thickness 50mm (with supplied fixings)
- Accepts 8mm Corston spindle (supplied)
