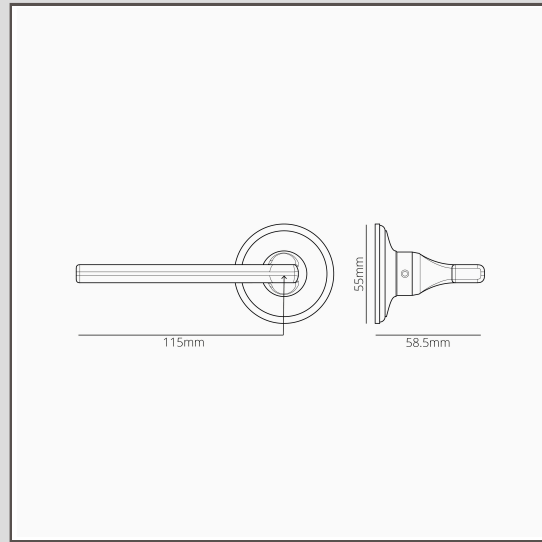


## Clayton Sprung Door Handle – Antique Brass

Clayton is probably our most modern door handle thanks to its sleek, flat-surfaced lever (the front-facing surface still has a subtle curve to it for a really pleasing overall feel).

It comes with a sprung mechanism inside which is strong enough to take the weight of the solid brass handle and stop it sagging over time. It means you can pair it with any latch.

There's also no danger of the handle coming away – the spindle is threaded onto the handle which holds it in place.

Antique brass is what's called a 'living' finish because it reacts to the air and moisture around it, causing it to darken (especially in the areas you touch most). We've given it a head start by ageing it by hand, so it has that antique look right out the box.
