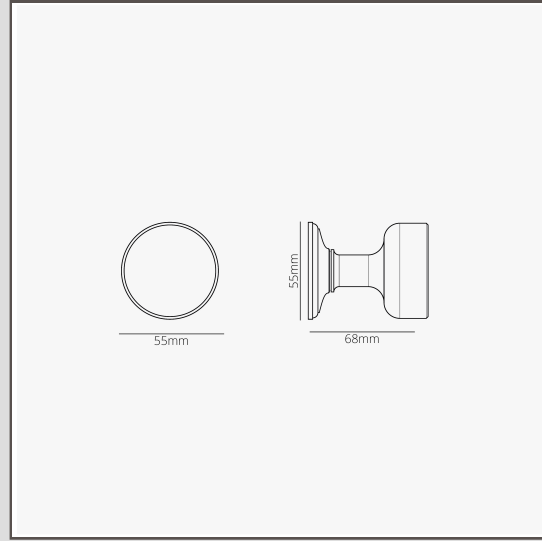


Onslow Sprung Door Knob - Antique Brass

Our flat-fronted Onslow door knob is a contemporary alternative to our beehive design.

The knob is sprung, which means you don't need to rely on the latch's spring for its movement.

There's also no danger of it coming away in your hand – the spindle is threaded onto the knob which holds it in place.

Antique brass is what's called a 'living' finish because it reacts to the air and moisture around it, causing it to darken (especially in the areas you touch most). We've given it a head start by ageing it by hand, so it has that antique look right out the box.

- Super smooth turn thanks to self-lubricating, high-tolerance bushings
- Sold in a pair
- Must be installed using our [45mm Forstner drill bit](#) and [door handle retro fitting kit](#)
- Dimensions: handle W54mm x H60mm; rose dia. 55mm
- Designed for use with a tubular latch or mortice lock
- Supplied with Corston sprung mechanism
- Suitable for interior doors only
- Minimum door thickness 35mm; maximum door thickness 50mm (with supplied fixings)
- Accepts 8mm Corston spindle (supplied)
