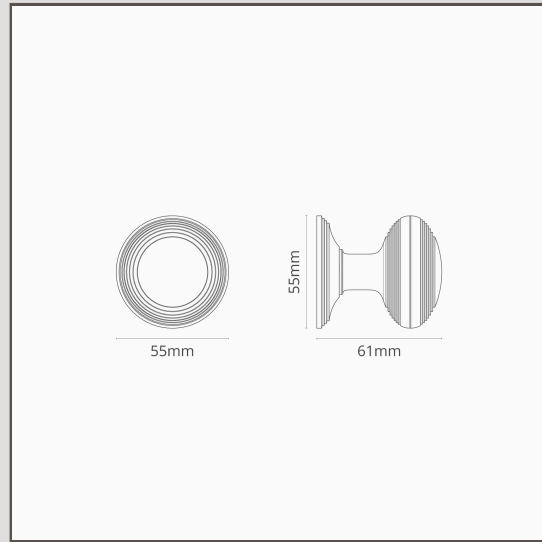


Poplar Unsprung Door Knob - Bronze

Our Poplar design in Bronze is our take on the classic Victorian beehive knob.

We've streamlined things, giving it a flatter knob and low-profile 'screwless' rose (the screws are hidden inside). It'll work great in period homes with a contemporary edge, or new homes that want to bring in a traditional touch.

This version of Poplar is unsprung, which means you can use it with an existing sprung latch. To make sure it stays easy to turn, we'd recommend using a lightly sprung latch.

There's also no danger of the knob coming away in your hand – the spindle is threaded onto the handle which holds it in place.

Bronze is our boldest finish, but it isn't shiny or bright, so it has a subtle side to it too. It's a deep matt brown colour that's almost black in some lights.
